Bobby would take the lead on lap 15 and it looked like we might get our first win of the season, But as the race went on, the bottom groove became the fast way

One thing that makes Shepp's unique is the Speedway Bar & grill that overlooks turns 3&4 of the speedway. The other is the track....it is a very small 1/4 mile with little to no banking in the turns. While we knew that the smaller tracks were usually hard to pass on and hard on equipment we wanted to give this track a try. And they were paying \$1000 to the winner...so why not.

Starting outside of the front row turned out to be the beginning of the end for us at this place. With very little room to maneuver and the low line being the preferred way around Bobby quickly fell to third which is where he finished.
